Objective



To have in place, at the end of three years, a fully implementable policy tool, applicable for all 22 coastal states of the EU, which will enable <u>the self-assessment of the sustainability of local authorities.</u>



- ✓ to increase the sustainability of partner municipalities through interchange of experience and transfer of practice during the lifetime of the project, as well as beyond, on sustainability issues,
- ✓ to draw up <u>a definitive list of sustainability criteria</u> for a coastal future which can be readily implemented.
- ✓ to <u>self-assess the identified sustainability criteria</u> in order that they can be used on a Pan-European scale.

What is the Policy Tool?

A new way of thinking about sustainability through the development of the DeCyDe policy tool. This is a unique way of scoring a set of pre-existing indicators related to key aspects of the EU Sustainable Development Strategy *viz*.

Governance,
Environmental quality,
Economics, &
Social well-being.

Wider sustainaibility context

Transfer of beneficial ideas from the partner regions, allowing

- ✓ Economic revitalisation of some areas, and
- ✓ Equalising cross cultural disparities, in order to
- ✓ Improve the socio-economic balance between coastal communities.









SUSTAIN What have we done...?

SUSTAIN partners gathered at:

6 workshops to explore and discuss sustainability topics, criteria and methodologies for scoring the indicators



SUSTAIN What have we done...?

... Which were complemented by 6 inter-regional visits that enabled partners to exchange their own experiences on sustainability issues allowing transfers of best practice when applicable.



Examples of best practices transferred...

- Converting organic, agricultural waste into material suitable for surfacing local footpaths (from The Netherlands to Cyprus)
- ✓ Displaying plastic degradation times at beaches and harbours (from France to Northern Ireland UK)
- ✓ Crossing a political divide (from Turkey/Cyprus to UK)
- ✓ A cross-cutting inter-departmental governance consortium to manage coastal areas (from Spain to Italy)

✓ Contribution to the implementation of the EU Sustainable Development Strategy


